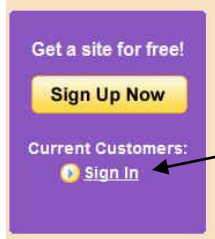


Uploading your work to Yahoo! Geocities

1. Go to geocities.yahoo.com
2. Log in by selecting Sign In (You must have a yahoo address.)



3. Type in your yahoo username and password and click Login



4. Choose Manage from the options at the top.



5. Now choose File Manager.



6. Choose Open File Manager.

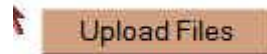


7. Choose the Upload button and 'upload' your FILE (something.htm)



8. Now choose browse and select your file. Remember it will end in .htm.

When you have finished and the file name appears, click

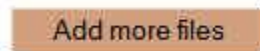



Easy Upload

Transfer files from your computer to your main directory with this simple tool. First click on **Browse...** to select files, then click **Upload Files**.

Note: File names **cannot** contain spaces. The total upload can be up to 5MB.

9. You are taken back to the File Manager. You should see your file name listed. If not hit the  and they should appear. If not, retry steps 7 and 8.
10. You should be able to click View at the end of your file and see your web page appear. However, since you haven't uploaded any graphics yet, you will not have any graphics appearing on your page.
11. Let's make a SUBDIRECTORY so your graphics will have somewhere to go.



12. Type in the name of the subdirectory (just like it is on Drive) Something_files.....

13. Now you are taken back to your files. Let's get in our folder by selecting it.
14. Now we are inside the folder for our graphics.



15. Upload your graphic files (just like you did it in steps 7 – 9)
16. Choose Up one level...and you should be back at your original file.

17. You should now be able to view it and it should show up correctly.



Take note of the address on the Internet Explorer Bar – That is what you give to anyone who wants to view your web page.!
